






























Heloisa's Humming Bird (*Atthis heloisa*).







FIG. 1. FLORES'S HUMMING BIRD (*Selasphorus floresi*) Gould. (From a specimen in the collection of Walter E. Bryant (No. 2520). San Francisco, California.)










Fig. 1. FLORE'S HUMMING BIRD (*Selasphorus floresi*) Gould. (From a specimen in the collection of Walter E. Bryant (No. 2550). San Francisco, California.)
