














Chestnut cap'd Tanager
























Fig. 1. POPELAIRE'S THORN-TAIL (*Popelaria popelairii*). (After Gould.)




Fig. 1. POPELAIRE'S THORN-TAIL (*Popelairia popelairii*). (After Gould.)
